Spring Clean-up: Council will once again have its annual spring clean-up. Please note this will be a general clean-up and any materials from demolition of buildings, sheds or trees cut down from properties will not be collected. Any small loose material must be boxed or bagged. **All metal items must be placed separate from the regular clean-up garbage as it won't be collected otherwise.** Do not place tires, rope or netting out for garbage pick-up as they will not be collected. Please have all garbage placed on the side of the road by **Tuesday, May 9, 2017**. We will not be returning to collect garbage in the areas that have already been covered.

Council is requesting that residents refrain from putting garbage in the drains around the community. It would be very much appreciated if residents could ensure there is no garbage in the drains in front of their properties. This will prevent any damages that may occur in the event of heavy rainfall. Please ensure that any garbage put out for pick up is covered to prevent it from being torn open, which causes some of the garbage to end up in the drains.

Please keep regular weekly garbage separate from bulk garbage.

Thank you for your cooperation in this matter. We all need to work together to keep our community clean and beautiful.

Reminder: Tidy Towns will also be having their Community Clean-up on Sunday May 28, 2017 from 2:00pm – 5:00pm. Everyone will meet at the Tourist Information Centre. Hope to see everyone come out to help keep our community clean and beautiful.

Note for dog/cat and animal Owners: The Town is asking that if you are disposing of animal feces that it is done so in appropriate containers such as buckets or containers with lids. Please do not place animal feces in garbage bags only as it is unsanitary for staff if a bag breaks open.
